POLICY OF PROJECT "ALAY DAHON"

To the: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
School Superintendents

1. In connection with project "Alay Dahon" of the Department of Education and Culture, launched in accordance with Department Memorandum No. 94, s. 1975, it is desired that all provincial and city schools superintendents submit to their respective Regional Directors a brief report of the following:

- a. Approximate area of sites identified for tree planting, or in which some trees have already been planted (shown in simple sketch of location plan);
- b. Kinds and number of trees already planted and growing;
- c. Kinds of seedlings needed indicating whether they can be secured in the division;
- d. List of problems encountered in the implementation of the aforementioned Department Memorandum; and
- e. Alternative / revision plans to carry out the purposes of the project more effectively.

2. It is further desired that the Regional Directors submit this report as soon as possible but not later than March 30, 1976.

3. Finally, the regional Directors are hereby urged to recommend to this Office, as part of their reports, one or two places in the region which may be visited by the Department Committee created for evaluation purposes, relative to Paragraph 9(f) of the aforesaid Department Memorandum s. 94, s. 1975.
