NOMINATION FOR SEAMEO REGIONAL ENGLISH
LANGUAGE CENTRE

1. The SEAMEO Regional English Language Centre in Singapore has announced its invitation for nominations to the:

Three-month Specialized Advance Course on
Sociolinguistics from June 7 to September 4, 1976.

2. The three-month course is intended to stimulate sociolinguistics research in the SEAMEO region leading to results useful to language teaching and language development. It is designed for key personnel in the field of language teaching with special interest in the social aspects of language. It will also be useful to scholars in the field of sociology or anthropology with an interest in language and language education. The following guidelines for selection of candidates may be used.

The nominees may be:

- a. Lecturers in linguistics at universities or teacher training institutions;
- b. Lecturers in sociology with interest in language and education;
- c. Officials of language units and language development centers.

The course members should preferably have a university degree with major in language, linguistics or language teaching, or in a field with particular interest in language study.

Each nomination should be accompanied by the following:

- a. A copy of the enclosed form properly accomplished.
- b. A medical certificate from a government clinic certifying that the nominee is medically fit for the three-month course.
- c. Transcript of records for both undergraduate and graduate courses.
- d. If married, a written permission to participate in the program from the spouse.
- e. Clearance from the Office.

3. The National Committee will select, from among the nominees, five candidates who will be notified to report to the DSO before April 10, 1976, to fill out some forms. Their names and duly accomplished forms will be forwarded to REIC on April 10 for final acceptance.

4. The selected participants will be given free transportation to and from Singapore, a book allowance and lodging privileges during the period of their program at the Regional English Language Centre in Singapore. They will also receive regular salaries from their agencies during this period.

5. Please give this matter priority attention.
