IN-SERVICE TRAINING FOR TEACHER TRAINERS OF
COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

1. Conformably with the Memorandum of Agreement signed by the Secretaries of the Department of Education and Culture, and the Department of Local Government and Community Development (DLGCD), and the President of the Philippine College of Educators (PCE), two sets of in-service training for teacher trainers on Cooperative Education will be held from April 25 to May 9, 1976 at Agricultural Credit and Cooperative Institute (ACCI), U.P., Los Baños, Laguna. One set will be for rural teachers and the other for urban teachers.

2. The in-service training is in preparation for the tryout of guides and self-learning kits prepared during the live-in writing workshop held at the PCE from April 21 to May 21, 1976.

3. The objectives of the in-service training are as follows:

- a. To provide the participants with up-to-date information on the government's policies on cooperative development, as well as on Santhang Bayan, Kilusang Bayan, and other cooperative organizations.
- b. To enable the participants to review the prepared guidelines and teaching outlines.

4. To provide opportunities for the participants to exchange ideas on methods of teaching co-operatives.
5. To enable the participants to gain experiences in the systematic organization of school co-operatives.

4. Included is a list of the selected pilot schools and divisions from which the delegates for the in-service training will be drawn. Each pilot school and division is requested to send to the Chief, Curriculum Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, DEO, the names of its outstanding teachers in the various subject areas and levels on or before April 16.
