MAXIMIZING THE PARTICIPATION OF SCHOOLS
IN THE 1976 NATIONAL MUSIC COMPETITION FOR YOUNG ARTISTS

To the: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges
and Universities
Schools Superintendents

Please find herunder portions of a letter of the Director, Chefs de la Performing Arts, Cultural Center of the Philippines, dated March 1, 1976, for the information and guidance of all concerned:

"We have made initial preparations for the 1976 National Music Competition for Young Artists. For the First Lady's Young Artists Foundation. This will highlight the National Music Week held every year from November 27 to December 2 under Presidential Decree No. 1773.

"We would like to involve as much participation as possible from both public and private elementary and secondary schools, hoping to discover and encourage more potential artists. This is in line with the government's cultural development program for the young.

"In view of the timeliness of the project, may we request your good office to kindly endorse the program through all the Regional Directors and District Superintendents who are in closer contact with our schools nationwide."

2. In view of the importance of developing in the youth an awareness of their talent in music and in furtherance of the President's policy of developing our national identity through cultural activities, it is enjoined that as many school children and students as are interested in music be encouraged to participate in the competitions.

3. It is desired that this Department Memorandum be given as wide publicity as possible in all schools, colleges and universities.
