1. The Department of Education and Culture Population Education Program and the Population Center Foundation are jointly sponsoring a series of research utilization seminars for selected teachers, principals, supervisors, superintendents, policy-makers and researchers at the Research Center for National Defense and Development, Fort Bonifacio, Makati, Rizal, on the following dates:

2. The objective of these seminars is to review and react to population education research materials, both local and foreign, with focus on teacher training.

3. Population Center Foundation and Population Education Program will provide round-trip plane tickets to participants who will travel by air, while other participants will be reimbursed their transportation expenses upon registration. In addition, each participant will be entitled to a daily stipend of ₱45 for meals and lodging.

4. Copies of conference materials will be sent in advance to participants for study to maximize interaction during the plenary and group sessions.

5. Participants will be housed at ADOA Dormitory, National Defense College of the Philippines Compound, Fort Bonifacio, Makati, Rizal.

6. Enclosed is the list of participants, by levels, who have been selected following interviews by the PEP Research Staff.

7. All directors and heads of offices concerned are enjoined to give this matter their preferential attention.
