1975 CONFERENCE OF SCHOOLS SUPERINTENDENTS

1. The 1975 Conference of Schools Superintendents will be held on April 28 - May 1, at Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The theme of the conference is "Education and the Changing Needs of Philippine Society."
2. The following are authorized to attend the Conference: Bureau Directors and Assistant Bureau Directors; Heads of Cultural Agencies; Schools Division Superintendents; Vocational Schools Superintendents; Staff Service Chiefs, Division Chiefs of Staff Services and Staff Bureaus (D.P.H., D.S.E., D.H.S.); Heads of Special Units under the Office of the Secretary; Presidents of State Colleges and Universities; representatives of the Private Educational Associations (CEAF, PACE, ACSC, FAPSCD); representatives from IEP/AF; and a representative from each of the Philippine Association of Retired Superintendents and the PPSEA. Other officials not specified above whose services may be required in the Conference will be duly notified and given proper authority by this Office.
3. Inclosed is the program of the Conference. It may be noted that the group sessions will be devoted to a re-assessment of existing DEC programs and policies to determine their relevance to the changing needs of Philippine society with a view to coming up, as a result of such evaluation, with recommendations for revisions or redirection of such programs and policies to conform with identified needs. Suggested critical areas which will serve

as basis for a reassessment of existing policies taking into account the new development thrusts that may be discussed by the conference speakers are likewise enclosed.

4. It is desired that participants go over the suggested critical areas in Inclosure No. 2 to this Department Memorandum and do advance reassessment or otherwise secure various views on such areas from other sectors concerned directly or indirectly with education.

5. A conference registration fee of P150 will be charged each participant, exclusive of the usual charges for accommodation and meals by Teachers Camp. Traveling expenses of participants are chargeable against funds of their respective offices.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Department Memorandum is hereby desired.
