TRAINING ON WATER SAFETY

To the: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities  
Schools Superintendents

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines will conduct a live-in Training on Water Safety in Mt. Makiling, Los Baños, Laguna, on April 19 to 22, 1976. A group of Australian experts on water safety will conduct the training.

2. In order to promote water safety in all communities, it is desired that all school divisions with swimming pools open to students and the public, send representatives. Colleges and universities, both public and private, may also send delegates. All applications should be sent to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Manila, before April 19. For further details contact the said Office.

3. The course shall be a live-in Training; instruction to be conducted from morning to evening. Each delegate shall pay a registration fee of P120 which includes all expenses. The subjects to be taken up are swimming, resuscitation, methods of water rescue and water first aid.

4. Expenses of Physical Education Supervisors and others who are government employees may be charged against local funds, subject to availability of funds, and the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
