ANNUAL WORK CONFERENCES OF THE PAFSSA, PAVIP AND PASSA

To the: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinators, State Colleges
and Universities
School Superintendents

1. The Annual Work Conferences of the Philippine Association of Public Secondary School Administrators (PAFSSA), the Philippine Association of Vocational Education Principals (PAVIP) and their federated group of the Philippine Association of Secondary School Administrators (PASSA) in coordination with the Department of Education and Culture will be held at the Zamboanga City High School, Zamboanga City, from June 28 to July 2, 1976.

2. The theme of the work conferences is: "The 1973 Secondary Education Program: Its Focus on Economic Self-Reliance."

3. The objectives of the work conferences are as follows:

a. Develop among the participants:

1. Awareness of the problems encountered in the full implementation of the whole program as related to the needs and resources of the community and how to resolve them with the resource limitations.
2. An innovative outlook as to the possible approaches and strategies in the choice of vocational as well as academic elective offerings relevant to the needs of the students in a developing community.

b. Draft a school action program maximizing school and community facilities and resources for the enrichment of curricular offerings through the involvement of private and government agencies in the community.

c. Provide feedbacks for the improvement of the present program based on the evaluation of the first three curriculum years that implemented the program.

4. Principals of regular high schools and vocational schools, chiefs and assistant chiefs of the Secondary Education Division of the regional offices and the divisions of the Bureau of Secondary Education are authorized to attend the conferences. Assistant principals of regular and canopy high schools and heads of private high schools, may also attend the work conferences. The latter will attend as observers. All delegates and observers should come with their impressions of the implemented 1973 Revised Secondary Education Program which will include data on: (1) the social and economic conditions of the community where the high school is situated, with focus on manpower needs at the second level; and (2) the agencies by which the school can tap available resources both material and manpower in order to provide realistic opportunities for learning and working.

5. Travel expenses and registration fees will be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. A registration fee of two hundred pesos (200) will be charged the delegates to cover seminar paraphernalia. Those participating as observers will be charged one hundred fifty pesos (150).

6. Registration of delegates and observers is Monday, June 28, 1976 at the Zamboanga City High School, Zamboanga City. To be assured of board and lodging, delegates and observers should wire the superintendents of Zamboanga City not later than June 18, 1976.

7. It is desired that this Department Memorandum be given wide dissemination among the high school administrators and the other school officials concerned.
