ADDENDUM TO DEPARTMENT MEMORANDUM NO. 115, s. 1976

To the: Regional Directors  
School Superintendents

1. Conformably to the suggestion of school superintendents who attended the Conference in Baguio City, the Philippine Teacher Selection Test will be administered simultaneously throughout the country on Tuesday, June 1, 1976 at 8:30 A.M.
2. The Philippine Teacher Selection Test will be administered only in school divisions that have requested for it. These requests which should include the number taking the test should be received at the National Educational Testing Center (NETC) on or before May 15, 1976, to allow ample time for the preparation and packing of test materials.
3. Where the headquarters of a provincial and city school divisions are in the same city, teacher-examinees from these divisions would take the test in a place most convenient for the greater number of examinees. Provisions, therefore, should be made for enough rooms, allotting thirty (30) teacher-examinees and one proctor per examination room. The superintendents concerned shall coordinate their efforts toward this end.
4. All test materials will be delivered to and retrieved from, the headquarters of the provincial division by an NETC representative assigned to coordinate with the school superintendent in that particular division.
5. The results of the examination will be released on or before June 30, 1976 by the National Educational Testing Center. A copy of the results of the tests indicating scores obtained by each examinee shall be furnished the regional and division offices concerned.

6. All school personnel who will serve as examiners or proctors during the examination day will be granted one day service credit for this assignment. Needless to say, those examiners and proctors will be briefed by the HSTC representative and by the superintendent or his representative at their duties during the examination day.

7. This Department Memorandum should be brought to the attention of all concerned.
