AUTHORIZING THE BAROCLOS FOUNDATION OF THE PHILIPPINES,
INC. TO CONDUCT A NATIONWIDE EDUCATIONAL
AND FUND CAMPAIGN

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Officers of Schools and Heads of Schools
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
District Superintendents

1. Addressed is Proclamation No. 1545 of His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, dated May 13, 1976, authorizing the Baroclos Foundation of the Philippines, Inc. (BFI) to conduct a nationwide educational and fund campaign during the period from March 1 to December 31, 1976.

2. The BFI, a civic and voluntary organization, complements the government's overall efforts to solve the multi-faceted drug abuse problem. Its programs of action are closely coordinated with the Dangerous Drugs Board, with a main thrust in the implementation of an integrated drug abuse prevention education, information, and training program as well as the establishment of its "Bahay Lakad" Treatment and Rehabilitation Center in Antipolo, Rizal.

3. The Proclamation specifically calls upon "all citizens and residents of the Philippines, irrespective of nationality or creed, to give generously and participate actively in this campaign and also help in the resounding of the hopes and aspirations of the youth who are victims of drug abuse to play their role in our society as useful adults."

4. In view of the fact that the Proclamation allows solicitation of contributions from persons, students, and parents and considering that such donations are 100% deductible from the donor's income tax gift tax returns, this Office hereby authorizes the campaign.

b. Remittances from each organization or school head shall be in check or money order drawn in favor of the Narcotics Foundation of the Philippines, Inc. and transmitted to the Regional Office, c/o the Regional Director, who in turn, shall transmit said check and money order to the Department of Education and Culture, c/o Undersecretary Narciso Alcantarilla, Campaign Chairman. In every case, the transmittal letter should indicate in summary form the sources of the collection. This is a modification of the previously adopted procedure to enable this Office to keep tab of the progress of the campaign and determine the extent of participation of all concerned.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Department Memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.

PROCLAMATION NO. 1545

AUTHORIZING THE MARCOTICS FOUNDATION OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC.
TO CONDUCT A NATIONWIDE EDUCATIONAL AND FUND CAMPAIGN
DURING THE PERIOD FROM MARCH 1 TO DECEMBER 31, 1976.

WHEREAS, it is the ardent concern of the Government
as well as of civic-minded citizens to fight the menace of
drug abuse so as to protect our youth and preserve their
health and welfare;

WHEREAS, the Narcotics Foundation of the Philippines,
Inc., a private non-profit organization, needs public sup-
port in its efforts to supplement the programs of the Govern-
ment in the treatment, rehabilitation and after-care services
of drug abusers, who are mostly school boys and girls; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation will expand its Rehabilitation
Center by erecting a new building, as part of the continuing
implementation of a comprehensive program against drug abuse;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND R. MARCOS, President of
the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law,
do hereby authorize the Narcotics Foundation of the Philip-
pines, Inc. to conduct a nationwide educational and fund
campaign during the period from March 1 to December 31, 1976.

I call upon all citizens and residents of the Philip-
pines, irrespective of nationality or creed, to give generously
and participate actively in this campaign and thus help in
the realization of the hopes and aspirations of the youth who
are victims of drug abuse, to play their role in our society
as useful citizens.

All donations and contributions to the Anti-Sarcotics
Educational and Fund Campaign shall be exempt from income and
gift taxes, and the same shall constitute allowable deductions
from the income of the donors and contributors for income
tax purposes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused
the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
