NEW/REVISED PROGRAMS AND CURRICULUM IN THE UP
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATION

To the: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinators, State Colleges
and Universities

1. The University of the Philippines has recently approved the institution of new degree programs, revision of existing degree programs in the field of Educational Administration and their implementation beginning the second semester of the academic year 1975-1976. The new degree programs instituted are the Certificate in Education in Educational Administration (C. Ed.); Master of Education in Educational Administration without Special Problem (M. Ed.); and the Professional Diploma in Educational Administration (P. D.).
2. These different degree programs are intended to meet the different needs of distinct types of clientele. The C. Ed. is intended for lower-lower management positions (e.g. department heads and teachers-in-charge); the M. Ed. for upper-lower management positions (e.g. assistant principals, principals and district supervisors); the P. D. for middle management positions (e.g. assistant superintendents, superintendents and division supervisors; and the P. D. for top management positions or the career executive service (e.g. chief of divisions in the DEC, assistant regional directors, regional directors, assistant bureau directors, bureau directors and undersecretary).
3. All the degree programs below the doctorate's degree (i.e. C. Ed., M. Ed., Plans A and B and P. D.) emphasize the development of management skills in formulating educational policies relevant to regional and national development. The basic graduate programs (i.e. C. Ed. and M. Ed. Plan A and Plan B) seek to develop skills in

managing an individual school efficiently and effectively; the advanced degree programs (i.e. P.D. and Ed. D.) go beyond individual school management into the division, region and the nation.

4. All the degree programs seek to develop research skills but the objective differs by the levels and by the program within a level. The C. Ed., A. Ed., Plan B and P.D. all without special problem - seek to develop the ability to interpret and utilize scientific research findings in educational management. The M. Ed. Plan A and Ed. D. - both with special problem/dissertation - aim to develop research skills in designing, implementing, evaluating and utilizing scientific research findings in educational management and policy development, respectively. The difference in the research objective between the two research-oriented degree programs lies in emphasis. At the masteral level Plan A, the emphasis is on research on educational management; while at the doctoral level, the emphasis is on policy formulation and development.

5. Inquiries regarding details of these new and revised degree programs may be directed to the Dean, College of Education, University of the Philippines System, Diliman, Quezon City.

6. It is desired that this Department Memorandum be given wide dissemination in the school divisions for the benefit of the school officials and administrators who are interested in these programs at the state university.
