DEADLINE FOR FILING INCOME TAX RETURNS

To the: Bureau Directors

1. Inclosed with this Department Memorandum is a letter from the Commissioner of Internal Revenue, Distr. 1, Manila, in connection with the deadline for filing of Income Tax Returns.
2. In this connection, it is requested that the contents of the letter, especially that of paragraph 2, be discussed in conferences and meetings with teachers, parent teacher associations, barangay and community leaders by all Department of Education and Culture officials concerned. This way the B&E taxation education campaign will be of great help to our revenue directors and revenue district officers in their campaign to bring in more income tax filers this year.
3. It is desire that this Department Memorandum be disseminated to all schools superintendents and college/university presidents.

Sir:

Pursuant to the DBC-A Memorandum of Agreement, we would like to seek the assistance of all regional directors, division superintendents, supervisors, principals and classroom teachers to bring the message of government to the parents during the season of filing income tax returns starting January 2, 1976.

Our information-education campaign has been divided into three stages, namely:

1. February 16 - deadline for taxpayers whose gross income is below ₱1,800 but are nevertheless required to file income tax returns. They should use BIR Form 1701B.
2. March 15 - deadline for taxpayers whose incomes are derived from salaries or from fixed sources. They should use BIR Form 1701A.
3. April 19 - deadline for taxpayers whose incomes are derived from business or from non-fixed sources. They should use BIR Form 1701.

In this connection, we request that a memorandum circular be issued to all DBC officials entitling them to extend their help to our revenue directors and revenue district officers in the campaign to bring in more income tax filers this year.

Enclosed is the revised text of a BIR announcement regarding the three deadlines.
