- d. Have leadership qualities
- e. Not elected for any scholarship for the next two years

5. Each participant shall be entitled to a stipend of THIRTY-FIVE PESOS (P35.00) per day for the duration of the training program and a reimbursement of the transportation expenses in going to and returning from Manila, Iloilo, subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
