SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON SEED PRODUCTION

To the:

Bureau Directors
Regional Directors of Regions I and II
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. The National Executive Committee of the Green Revolution, National Food and Agricultural Council (NFAC), United States Agency for International Development (USAID), University of the Philippines at Los Baños (UPLB), and the Department of Education and Culture (DEC) will jointly sponsor a ~~Seminar-Workshop on Seed Production~~ at the Ifugao Agricultural and Technical College, Bayon, Lamit, Ifugao on February 16-20, 1976 and at the Jones Rural School, Jones, Isabela on March 8-12, 1976.
2. The main objective of the seminar is to upgrade the skills and competencies of elementary parent teachers and secondary food production teachers of both public and private schools, division food production coordinators and food production teachers of vocational schools and to involve all school administrators and other school personnel in the production of quality vegetable seeds.
3. Each division/zone concerned shall send to the seminar-workshop two elementary parent teachers, one practical arts supervisor or food production coordinator, two food production teachers from the public secondary schools, two from the private schools, one home economics supervisor, and one food production teacher from each vocational school (a agriculture, trade and fishery). The Regional Agricultural Supervisor assigned to coordinate the Green Revolution Program for the region is likewise requested to attend.
4. All provincial schools superintendents, vocational school superintendents and vocational school administrators may attend either the opening or closing program.
5. All participants in the seminar should be at the seminar site one day before the opening date of the seminar. A registration fee of forty pesos (P40) will be charged from each delegate.

6. Transportation and other expenses of public school participants incident to their attendance in this seminar/workshop will be covered by the school divisions/schools; those coming from the Department will charge their expenses from the Department of Education and Culture Travel Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Visiting teachers and private school participants, whose schools concerned are strongly urged to provide for their expenses.

7. A program of activities for this seminar and a list of provinces where the school divisions and schools are located are enclosed for the guidance of all those concerned.

8. The school divisions and schools in the provinces of Benguet and Mountain Province and the City of Baguio, all in Region I, who failed to send participants to the Seed Production Seminar in the Speaker Enrique Perez National Agricultural School, San Carlos City (Pangasinan) and Burgos National Agricultural School, Burgos, Ilocos Norte are requested to send their participants at the Ifugao Agricultural and Technical College, Lamut, Ifugao or the Sataw school tent.
