PRACTICAL ARTS WORKSHOPS AND TEACHING INSTITUTES

To the: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
School Superintendents

1. A series of seminar-workshops and regional practical arts teaching institutes for the try-out schools under the Text-book Project will be conducted with the Educational Development Project Implementing Task Force as the coordinating agency. Inclosed is a list of try-out schools.
2. The dates, venue and participants to these workshops and institutes are indicated below:

March 29 to April 10, 1976 EPACT on PA, BDA and WE	PCIEP, Manila	Four representatives each from IATs; two for secondary practical arts and two for elementary work education; including PAME supervisors on the 2nd week training.
April 25 to May 24, 1976 EPACT on PA, BDA and WE	All eleven IATs	Four participants each from DFS and DRCs, including representatives of selected secondary and elementary schools, and regional and division subject supervisors in practical arts.

3. The institutes/workshops constitute, at the same time, a part and a supporting activity of materials development project of the Department. They shall not only serve as a forum for exchanging and upgrading practical arts teaching competencies in coordination with the academic subjects but shall also serve as a means for the development of teaching concepts necessary in the development of curriculum guides, teaching guides and textbooks as part of the Textbook Project.
4. The following guidelines shall be observed:
  - a. Training reference shall be the curriculum and teaching guides prepared by PCCU, CMBU and PCC for practical arts; SEC, SSC, and HS-SEC for academic components. The frame of reference will be D.O. No. 22, s.c. 1973 for practical arts and D.O. No. 10, s. 1970 for work education. Activities shall aim at their effective utilization of instructional materials/prototype tools.
  - b. Each seminar/workshop shall not have more than fifty participants.
  - c. Participation shall be by invitations. EDPITAF shall notify the try-out schools who shall then nominate their participants directly to the training center. Participation of non-try-out schools representatives and representatives of regional and division offices shall be upon the recommendation of the training center head, subject to prior concurrence of EDPITAF.
  - d. Participants to the two-week National Practical Arts Teaching Institute and other teaching/training activities to be determined by the Basic Education Sector, EDPITAF, shall charge their transportation cost to their institutions. However, EDPITAF shall provide the appropriate stipends and allowances for attendance.
  - e. Expenses for transportation (regular, economy fare), stipends and training allowances for the participants to the Regional Practical Arts Teaching Institutes for those coming from the try-out schools shall be borne by EDPITAF. EDPITAF will shoulder only stipends and training allowances of representatives from non-try-out schools and those coming from regional and division offices.

- f. Training Centers shall be responsible for developing, coordinating, implementing and supervising their respective training activities consonant with the guidelines set by EDPITAF and as agreed upon during the Training Design Workshop.

5. This Department Memorandum amends all other previous regulations issued by this Office which are in conflict with it. This project shall be funded and coordinated by EDPITAF subject to its usual program management procedures and in accordance with auditing rules and regulations.
