THREE LEVELS OF MASS TRAINING OF TEACHERS
ON THE USE OF NEW TEXTBOOKS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents

1. The mass training of teachers on the use of Grades I and II textbooks and manuals in science, mathematics and Pilipino shall be conducted at three levels to prepare trainers and teachers for the effective utilization of the books in the school year 1977-1978.

2. At the end of each training program, the participants should be able to:

- a. Explain the philosophy, objectives, and emphases of the new textbooks and manuals;
- b. Identify/demonstrate effective teaching strategies and instructional aids for specific lessons in the textbooks;
- c. Illustrate more acceptable ways of constructing achievement tests for selected portions of the textbooks;
- d. Develop five-day in-service training program on the use of the textbooks and manuals. (for levels 1 and 2 training only)

3. The level 1 training will be participated in by program coordinators from the 14 Regional Staff Development Centers (RSDCs) and the 12 DEC Regional Offices (DEC-ROs). This training program is scheduled as follows:

- a. Science (ESS 1 and ESS 2)
UP Science Education Center, Diliman, Quezon City
February 28-March 5, 1977
- b. Mathematics (ESM 1 and ESM 2)
UP Science Education Center, Diliman, Quezon City
February 28-March 5, 1977

c. Filipino (ESF 1 and ESF 2)
Sacred Heart Novitiate, Novaliches, Quezon City
March 7-12, 1977

4. UPSEC will invite additional participants in its training programs from among the division science and mathematics supervisors or coordinators. Selected participants will be informed through their regional directors or through their institutional heads.

5. The level 2 training will be conducted by the 14 RSDCs for division supervisors and teacher-trainers in their respective service areas. The RSDC directors will announce the schedule of training which will take place in March, 1977, and the expected participants from the divisions.

6. The level 3 training will be held in schools specifically designated by the schools superintendent as in-service training centers for this mass teachers training program. It will be held within the period April-May for all Grades I and II teachers. The schools superintendents will announce the division schedule of training which will be conducted by the division in-service training teams for science, mathematics and Filipino.

7. In view of the importance of this training program to our textbook development and utilization project, everyone is enjoined to extend his full support and cooperation.
