NATIONAL WORKSHOP-SEMINAR IN MUSIC EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. A national workshop-seminar in music education for the elementary grades under the joint sponsorship of the Philippine Society for Music Education and the Department of Education and Culture will be held at the Philippine Normal College auditorium, Manila, on May 29-31, 1977 on the theme: "Defining the Music Teachers' Accountability."

2. The objectives of the workshop-seminar are as follows:

- a. Restructuring teaching guides in music by grades for the elementary level based on the philosophy and program objectives drafted at the Development Academy of the Philippines sponsored by the Cultural Center of the Philippines, Music Promotion Foundation of the Philippines and the Philippine Society for Music Education on November 7-9, 1975.
- b. Suggesting learning experiences and preparing teaching materials appropriate for each grade.
- c. Peer demonstrations on effective music teaching strategies from the proposed teachers' guide.

3. Each division may send the division music supervisor, on official time, and at least two elementary music teachers, who will be granted service credits, to attend the workshop-seminar.
4. There will be a seminar-workshop fee of ₱30 which will cover handouts and other music materials.
5. Music coordinators and special music teachers from private schools may participate under the same conditions.
6. The tentative program of activities is attached.
7. Participants should bring to the workshop the following:
 - a. Unpublished authentic folk songs from their respective regions.
 - b. Rhymes, proverbs and singing games in the vernacular.
 - c. Music textbooks and other instructional materials such as teaching guides and locally produced musical instruments available in the division.
8. All applicants shall register not later than May 15, 1977 to be assured of a reservation.
