DEEPER INVOLVEMENT OF SCHOOL
ADMINISTRATORS IN SCOUTING

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools and Colleges

1. This Office has been informed that "while most administrators are over-zealous in their scouting interests and participatory activities, it is lamentable to note that there are still a considerable number who are apathetic to the cause of the boys and the girls."
2. The Scouting Movement is an integral part of the curricula of our schools, and therefore, it should be implemented seriously by school administrators both in public and private schools. Principals of public schools are reminded of the provisions of Circular No. 34, a. 1964 of the then Bureau of Public Schools indicating that assignment of teachers in scouting is considered part of the teachers' load. All school heads are enjoined to show more active interest by participating in the movement itself or supporting the movement within the rules and regulations of the Department of Education and Culture and the laws of the land.
3. Superintendents, district supervisors, principals, and head teachers should consider involvement in the scouting movement in the evaluation of the performance of teachers.
4. Supervisors on the national, regional, provincial, and local levels should be instructed to include this item in their supervisory reports.
