KOREAN CHILDREN'S CENTER ART EXHIBITION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. The Korean Children's Center Yock Young Foundation is holding its 19th World School Children's Art Exhibition on October 29, 1977 at the Korean Children's Center, Seoul, Korea.
2. The exhibition, to be held under the patronage of Korean National Commission for UNISON, Ministry of Culture and Information Ministry of Education, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and the Republic of Korea National Red Cross, is inviting participation from each country of about 50 to 60 elementary school children aged from 6 to 12 years.
3. Each participant shall submit one art work on any subject, in any of the following media: oil, water color, crayon, pastel, dessin, printing work, and collage. The maximum size is 55 cm. x 40 cm.
4. The following information, printed in English and in capital letters, should be attached to the back of the mat of each entry:
(a) full name of the participant (1) age and sex, (c) name and address of the school, (d) title of the work, and (e) nationality. Entries must be submitted to this Office on or before September 5 so that they can be sent to Seoul, Korea not later than September 20, 1977.
5. A number of prizes, certificates of merits, and medals will be presented to the selected participants.
6. In exchange for works submitted, the same number of Korean children's works will be sent to the school or club in each country by request.
7. Works submitted shall not be returned, instead they will be distributed to schools in Korea to promote interest in art education.
8. In view of the opportunity provided by this undertaking in developing the artistic talents of school children as well as in promoting international friendship and goodwill, it is desired that as many children as are interested be encouraged to participate in this art exhibition.

9. It is further requested that this Department Memorandum be given wide publicity among school children in the division.
