ANNOUNCING THE 1977-1978 YCAP CALENDAR

1. Conformably to Department Order No. 18, s. 1977, and pursuant to the directive of His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos to provide the youth truly meaningful experience in social and national service particularly in the rural and depressed communities, the thrust of this year's program shall be on "Youth Countryside Action for Progress (YCAP)."
2. For more effective coordination and impact of the YCAP, a year round activities have been identified and spelled out for the information and guidance of the field. The 1977-1978 YCAP calendar of activities is inclosed.
3. All school officials are enjoined to take the necessary steps to insure the proper observance and participation of all concerned in the activities listed in the 1977-1978 YCAP calendar.

1977-1978 YCAP CAMPAIGN OF ACTIVITIES

DATE	ACTIVITIES
June 6-10, 1977	<u>Echo-Seminar on the Revitalized YCAP (Youth Countryside Action for Progress)</u> Delegated to the Summer Institute for YCAP Coordinators (Phase I) are expected to map out plans and conduct echo-seminar for all divisions/schools coordinators.
June 25 and July 2, 1977	<u>Orientation on YCAP for Students in All Schools</u> School YCAP coordinators will orient YCAP enrollees on the revitalized YCAP including its rationale, objectives and program thrusts and spell out activities for student participation.
July 22, 1977	<u>Launching of YCAP Projects</u> Different regions/divisions/schools shall draw up plans and project proposals suited to the needs and resources of their respective communities. Formal launching of the project will be managed and undertaken by the regional/division/school YCAP coordinators with maximum participation of other agencies.
July 30, 1977 to March, 1978	<u>Follow-up of Projects</u> National/regional/division/school coordinators will conduct follow-up supervision of the projects launched. The National YCAP Coordinating Center and the Science Foundation of the Philippines personnel shall observe on-going YCAP projects in the regional, division and school levels.
December, 1977 to February, 1978	<u>Regional Consultative Conference on the Implementation of YCAP Action Plan</u> As the project progresses regional consultative conferences shall be conducted within the region.
February 10-14, 1978	<u>YCAP Week</u> To create awareness among the people in the community the YCAP celebration/programs shall be held on the regional, division and school levels.

March 6-11, 1978

YCAP Recognition Week

Identification and selection of the most outstanding YCAP projects/students/coordinators on the school/division/regional levels shall be conducted in preparation for the National YCAP Awards Day. Graduation ceremonies shall be held in each school for all YCAP participants for the year.

April 17-23, 1978

Floating University

At least one (1) male and one (1) female outstanding student leaders from each division throughout the country are enjoined to participate in the Floating University. This activity envisions the creation of a Youth Speakers Bureau on the Development Thrust of the Government and promote domestic tourism.

May 1, 1978

National YCAP Awards Day

Awarding ceremonies for outstanding national YCAP projects, coordinators/students, (in/out of school) and participating agencies.

May 7-27, 1978

Summer Leadership Institute for YCAP Coordinators

1. Participants who attended the first phase institute are expected to complete the final phases of the program.

2. Outstanding YCAP division/regional coordinators shall be selected to attend the second set of the institute.
