CHILDREN'S ART EXCHANGE AND PEN-PAL PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Coordinator, State Colleges  
and Universities  
Schools Superintendents  
Heads of Private Schools

1. The Svetlana M. Foundation, Inc., a people-to-people organization with the sole purpose to promote international friendship among the peoples of the world, is revitalizing its Children's Art Exchange and Pen-Pal Programs this year. Both are free and both are among its best friendship promotions projects.

2. The following are guidelines for participation in the Children's Art Exchange:

- a. The school principal sends to the Foundation as many children's art works, packed securely, by ordinary sea mail;
- b. In return the Foundation will ship the school an equal number of children's art works from different countries;
- c. The art teacher or principal is requested to exhibit these art works in a conspicuous public place.

3. For participation in the Philippine Pen-Pal Program, the guidelines are as follows:

- a. Anyone 14 years old and above can write the Foundation giving his name, address, age, sex, educational background and hobbies. The sender should enclose an International Reply coupon; /

- b. Each person will be matched individually as closely as possible to his or her requirements;
  - c. It is requested that no particular country be demanded as it is not always possible to match individuals because of language barrier.
