CHILDREN'S ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities,  
Schools Superintendents

1. The 1977 Annual National Convention of the Junior Members of the Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CML) in coordination with the Department of Education and Culture (DEC) will be held from October 18 to 22, 1977, at Teachers' Camp in Baguio City as a feature of its leadership-training program.

2. The theme for this year's youth assembly is 'The Individual in a Group: Vision and Commitment.'

3. The guidelines, in this connection, are the requirements for participants as prescribed by the CML:

- a. Each delegate and teacher-advisor shall pay P175 for convention fee to cover board and lodging as well as convention materials, P0.50 for delegate's junior membership fee and P1.00 for teacher-advisor's membership fee.
- b. To facilitate planning, registration, and arrangements for travel tickets, the enclosed forms should be fully accomplished and submitted to the CML office with the corresponding fees on or before October 7, 1977.
- c. Transportation expenses from their respective schools to Baguio City and back shall be borne by the delegates and teacher-advisors. For delegates from Baguio City of delegates from Cebu, Manila, Iloilo, and southern provinces, the assembly point shall be in front of the TRCA Youth Center, opposite the Manila City Hall at 5:00 A.M. on October 18, 1977, and will leave promptly for Baguio at 6:30 A.M. Delegates must bring their lunch for the trip. Schools which want their delegates to ride in the chartered buses should make their reservations not later than October 8, 1977.
- d. Pre-convention sessions shall be held to prepare the delegates and their teacher-advisors for the Baguio meeting.

- e. It is requested that participating schools organize their respective OMLI junior council chapters before the national convention.
- f. During the general roll call before the opening ceremonies, head delegates should submit their respective chapter reports for the past year. In the case of newly-organized chapters, their respective lists of officers and programs of action should be submitted.
- g. After the convention, the teacher-advisers and delegates, with the endorsement of the school principals, should initiate in their respective schools some conferences to which students from other schools in the locality may be invited. The materials used in Baguio City may be used for this purpose.
- h. Delegates should memorize by heart the "Oml, OMLI" the OMLI hymn, which will be sung during the opening ceremonies and before the opening of every session.
- i. The delegates should bring enough warm clothing for the cold weather in Baguio City. Male delegates should preferably wear coat and tie or karang Tapaing during the opening, turnover, and closing ceremonies.

4. In view of the benefits that may be realized from the convention, schools superintendents, district supervisors, and heads of schools are requested to encourage those concerned to attend the annual conference.
