STANDING DEPARTMENT MEMORANDUM NO. 64, s. 1977

To: Bureau Directors

1. Department Memorandum No. 64, s. 1977, entitled  
"Love A Lola' Essay Contest", is hereby amended as follows:

a. The fourth and fifth sentences of paragraph 3  
should read:

3. ... Deadline for submission of entries  
is August 15, 1977. No entry should be ac-  
cepted after five o'clock in the afternoon of  
August 15, 1977, except those sent by mail and  
postmarked not later than August 15, 1977.

b. Paragraph 5 should read:

5. The following prizes will be awarded to  
the winners:

- a. One first prize of P1,000
- b. One second prize of P1,000
- c. One third prize of P500
- d. Five consolation prizes.

Prizes will be awarded to the winners on Septem-  
ber 16, 1977, at the Pope Pius XII Catholic Center,  
J.F. Avenue, Manila.

c. The following should be added to paragraph 6:

The winners will be declared on August 22, 1977 by  
the Board of Judges composed of the following:  
Commissioner Carlos Guerrero Makpil, Supreme Court  
Justice Cecilia Muñoz Palma, Philippine Women's  
University President Leticia S. de Guzman,

Malibin Today Editor Benjamin F. Rodriguez,  
Philippine Daily Express President Manuel Villares,  
Igora Journal Executive Editor Manuel S. Salas,  
South Philippine Area Director Elizabeth C. Villanueva,  
PNF Trustee Loreto Faras Sulit, and former Senator  
Gerónimo T. Pauson.

2. It is desired that the aforementioned emblems be disseminated immediately to all schools, colleges, and universities.
