REGIONAL CONFERENCES TO INTRODUCE CURRICULUM  
MATERIALS ON ARRIVAL REPORT

1. The Department of Education and Culture, in cooperation with the Department of Agrarian Reform, will conduct regional conferences to introduce the curriculum materials on agrarian reform developed for elementary, secondary and higher education levels for integration into appropriate subject areas.

Attached as Inclosure No. 1 is a list of pilot schools and pilot divisions. It may be noted that the pilot divisions chosen are those where the regional conferences will be held to facilitate attendance of division supervisors concerned. Part of the conference activities is the tryout of the materials in the pilot schools. All school divisions and heads of pilot schools are requested to give full cooperation in this project.

3. Participants in each regional conference will be the Regional Director, the Chiefs of the Elementary, Secondary and Higher Education divisions in the Regional Office, the superintendent of the pilot division, and the subject supervisors of the pilot division.

4. Also included in a list of members of the Executive and Specialist Groups who will conduct the regional conferences. The Department of Education and Culture, the Department of Agrarian Reform, the University of the Philippines System and the University of the Philippines - Los Baños are represented in these groups.

5. Regional Directors and other officials of the Department of Education and Culture will coordinate and cooperate with their counterparts from the Department of Agrarian Reform in the conduct of this regional activity.

6. The Department of Agrarian Reform will shoulder the costs for transportation, per diem and subsistence incidental to this activity, for the Executive and Specialist Groups as listed in Inclosure No. 2 to this Memorandum.
