OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL STUDENTS' WEEK THIS YEAR

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. Conformably to Presidential Proclamation No. 1316 dated September 20, 1974, National Students' Week this year will be observed on September 20-27. Schools, colleges and universities are enjoined to carry out youth activities in community development, green revolution, nutrition education, physical fitness and sports development.
2. The Proclamation cites the Most Outstanding Coeds as one group of Filipino studentry signifying "their dedication toward spearheading youth projects in line with government policies and strengthen the bond between the students, the youth and the government."
3. This year, the Most Outstanding Coeds (MOC) and the Love Bank will hold the "Hakbang Love Bank" on September 24, 1977. The "Hakbang Love Bank" is a walk-for-a-cause which is geared to MOC community development projects. An example is the construction of communal baths in depressed areas. The walk will end at the Quirino Grandstand, Rizal Park, Manila where a simple program will be held.
4. Full support and assistance to the Most Outstanding Coeds of Metro Manila and Love Bank is urged.
5. Wide dissemination of this Department Memorandum is desired. An account of the observance of National Students' Week should be included in the annual reports of regional directors and schools superintendents.
