ATTEND EDUCATIONAL AND PUPILS' CAMPAIGN THROUGH
THE SALE OF TUBERCULOSIS SEALS

1. The improvement of health services in the provincial and rural areas is one of the goals set by His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos as a means of developing a healthier citizenry. Among the most dedicated entities implementing this humanitarian objective is the Philippine Tuberculosis Society, Inc.
2. As in previous years, the Philippine Tuberculosis Society, Inc. is requesting this Office again to endorse the sale of Tuberculosis Seals to help finance its services to indigent TB-sufferers.
3. Educational authorities of public and private institutions are therefore enjoined to lend maximum assistance in increasing the sale of Tuberculosis Seals to pupils and students not only to serve a good cause, but also to teach our young citizens the virtue of good citizenship.
4. The Tuberculosis Seals will be mailed to the schools and colleges in Metro Manila and in the provinces. They may also be secured from different branches of the Society in the provinces. Proceeds from the sale of the seals should be sent direct to the Philippine Tuberculosis Society, Inc., Quezon Institute, Julegio Rodriguez Avenue (España Ext.), Quezon City, or to the branches of the Society in the provinces.
5. The utmost cooperation of all concerned is requested.
