COUNTRYWIDE LECTURES ON FIRE PREVENTION
AND SAFETY CONSCIOUSNESS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges
and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools

1. In view of the tremendous losses our country has suffered from fires, Castle World Philippines, a private organization, is conducting free of charge one-hour lectures on fire prevention and safety consciousness in both private and public schools. This campaign is in line with the National Disaster Preparedness Program of the Office of the Civil Defense.
2. Considering the importance of inculcating safety consciousness among our people, it is but fitting for the schools to take the lead in giving school officials, teachers and students opportunities to attend the lectures.
3. In this connection, it is suggested that a period of not more than 60 minutes be set aside for the lecture. As much as possible, a good number of the school population must be encouraged to attend this highly informative lectures. The theme covered by the lectures must be the focus for class discussion and allied activities.
4. It is desired that this Department Memorandum be immediately disseminated in the field.
