AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BUST RELIEF OF THE PRESIDENT  
AND A P. LIVING DEPICTING THE PRESIDENT AND THE FIRST LADY  
PLANTING RICE FOR DISPLAY IN SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities  
School Superintendents

1. This Office hereby authorizes all local school boards to appropriate such portion of their share of the Special Education Fund for the purchase of the following items at the prices indicated:

- a. Bust relief of His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, size 10" x 22" x 1/2" made up of special aluminum metal sheet pressed on steel mould to produce the bust. The aluminum metal sheet is anodized or chrome finished embedded on a 1/2" of the metal sheet. The plywood is varnished colored mahogany. The words "His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos" are in anodized aluminum metal sheet by Forli Craft Manufacturing of the Philippines, Inc., Dian Street, Makati, Metro Manila ..... F225
- b. Oil painting on canvas depicting President Ferdinand E. Marcos and the first lady planting rice, size 25" x 30", without frame. The canvas is of fine tow-turn and durable stretched to an inner frame reinforced by wooden braces along the corners. The outer or main wooden frame is proportioned, carved and colored mahogany. The painting is in vibrant colors, about nine (9) kinds, from local and N.Y. oils and the work of a skilled portrait and landscape artist..... F810

2. Aside from their art value, the items can serve as inspiration to the school staff and the pupils/students.

3. It is desired that this Department Memorandum be disseminated to all chairmen of school boards for their information and guidance.
