ATTENDANCE IN IN-SERVICE TRAINING ACTIVITIES TO BE
CREDITED FOR PURPOSES OF PROMOTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. Effective October 1, 1977, attendance in the following activities may be given the corresponding credit for ranking and promotion purposes as an exception to General Letter No. 158 of the Bureau of Public Schools dated September 30, 1971:

- (a) 24-Hour Junior Red Cross Leadership Training Course;
- (b) Conferences, seminars and workshops conducted by certain organizations or agencies like the Philippine Association for the Retarded, Philippine Federation on Rehabilitation of the Disabled and Philippine Association of the Deaf for special groups of the teaching category.

2. Attention is invited to BPS Circular No. 6, s. 1972, regarding the number of points given for each level of in-service training activity. It is understood that credits for attendance in such activities will be given only insofar as such training or rating is relevant to the position.

3. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought to the attention of all school personnel concerned.
