ACCREDITATION OF SUMMER TRAINING
PROGRAMS IN FISHERIES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Vocational School Principals/Administrators,

1. All teachers and instructors who attended the three successive Summer Training Programs in Fisheries at the Marikina School of Arts and Trades shall be accredited as having completed all the requirements for the curriculum of Bachelor of Science in Fisheries in the following Schools and Colleges of Fisheries:

1. Aklan National College of Fisheries, New Washington, Aklan (Trainees from Regions VI, VII & VIII).
2. Apolinario Apacible School of Fisheries, Nasugbu, Batangas (Trainees from Regions III, IV, IV-A & V).
3. Sto. Tomas College of Fisheries, Sto. Tomas, La Union, (Trainees from Regions I & II).
4. Mindatao Regional School of Fisheries, Zamboanga City (Trainees from Regions IX, X, XI & XII).

2. A candidate for accreditation in this special summer program should submit the original copy of his/her transcript of records indicating completion of Technical Fishery or B.S. Fishery Education and the Certificates of Attendance for three summers, to the respective accrediting institution.

3. School fees required for graduation of regular students shall correspondingly be charged the applicants under this special program.

4. It is suggested that the teachers and instructors concerned be immediately advised of the contents of this Memorandum so that they can avail themselves of the benefits contained herein.
