FIFTH NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF THE UNESCO ASSOCIATED SCHOOLS
ON EDUCATION FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AND PEACE

The Fifth National Work-Conference of the Unesco Associated Schools Projects on Education for International Cooperation and Peace will be held on 12 to 16 December 1977 in Region V, Legazpi City, under the joint auspices of the Unesco National Commission of the Philippines and the National Research and Development Centre for Teacher Education, Department of Education and Culture.

The theme of the work-conference is, "Upgrading Projects of the Unesco Associated Schools in Support of National Plans of Action for International Cooperation and Peace." The over-all objective is to strengthen leadership in the Unesco associated schools projects and Unesco clubs and make them more development oriented in the light of the New Society goals.

Specifically, the participants in the work-conference are expected to:

- a. Render reports and exchange ideas on the latest information, strategies and innovative approaches on development utilized by teacher-advisers of Unesco clubs and associated schools projects in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels.
- b. Identify effective strategies that would further strengthen the existing programmes and activities of the Unesco clubs and associated schools project and make them relevant to the developmental needs of our society.
- c. Determine ways of integrating non-formal education for out-of-school youth in the associated schools projects so as to be increasingly contributive to national development.

- d. Discuss linkages of the associated schools projects and Unesco clubs with various civic and non-civic agencies in the community.
 - e. Formulate a year-round functional program of action on the three levels of education including non-formal education, that would enrich and update the present activities of Unesco clubs and projects of the Unesco associated schools.
 - f. Elect a National Board of Directors that would serve as the nucleus of a National Federation of Unesco Clubs and Associations.
4. Inclosure No. 1 is a tentative list of authorized participants to the work-conference who are actually involved in the Unesco associated Schools Projects. It is requested that these participants be informed immediately of their involvement.
5. Participants are requested to prepare a detailed description of their school or institution's activities, plans and problems to be reported during the conference in consonance with the listing of participating schools announced in Department Memorandum No. 104, s. 1976. An outline of said description is appended as inclosure No. 2.
6. If the participants listed in the inclosure cannot attend, the national coordinator of the Unesco associated schools through the NEDOTE, DEO should be informed immediately to enable the organizing committee to make definite plans for assignments, lodging and accommodation.
7. Transportation expenses and a registration fee of P75 are chargeable against local funds subject to availability and the usual accounting rules and regulations.
8. Board and lodging of the officially listed participants will be charged against the Unesco National Commission of the Philippines, starting with dinner on the 11th to breakfast on the 17th of December.
9. Superintendents and social studies Supervisors in Region V are encouraged to attend this conference provided that all their expenses will be charged against local or division funds.
