REGIONAL ECHO WORK-CONFERENCE ON MASTERY OF ARTS IN TEACHING ELEMENTARY AGRICULTURE (MATEA) PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. The National MATEA Work-Conference held in Cebu on November 16-18, 1977 revealed the urgent need to disseminate the concepts and goals of the program to school personnel and to the community. In view of this need, echo conferences on the regional level will be conducted by all the DEC Regional Offices starting December, 1977.

2. The objectives of the regional work-conferences are as follows:

- a. To further explore the role of the MATEA program in countryside development;
- b. To effect further commitment to the objectives and goals of the MATEA program; and
- c. To develop guidelines for the second phase of the MATEA program supportive to non-formal education.

4. Delegates to these work-conferences are officials and selected instructors from degree granting institutions, both private and public, learning centers administrators, MATEA regional coordinators and representatives of this Office.

5. To enrich the activities of the regional conferences, a demonstration on teaching science and agriculture, integrating various discipline, shall be provided.

6. A registration fee of P100 will be charged every delegate to defray work-conference expenses. Expenses for board and lodging, transportation and other allowances incidental to the attendance to these work-conferences including the registration fee will be charged against the respective MATEA funds or office of the delegate, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

7. Regional directors are enjoined to take active participation to this innovation.
