UNIFORM IDENTIFICATION CARDS (IDs) FOR STUDENTS
WITH BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION (BOT) MARKINGS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and
Universities

1. For the successful implementation of the reduced student fares, the Board of Transportation prescribes for students a common and uniform ID with BOT markings.
2. The printing of these IDs will involve funding at the cost of one peso (P1.00) per ID. To insure early implementation of the project, it is suggested that the respective schools advance the corresponding amounts and then collect the same from the students concerned.
3. The implementation of this project will start with all the schools in Metro Manila. The schools should submit to the Board of Transportation, Quezon City on or before December 20, 1977 the number of students needing IDs.
4. Based on payments made by the schools, the BOT will furnish the number of IDs needed which shall be distributed by the respective schools to the students concerned at one peso (P1.00) per ID.
5. The cooperation of all concerned in the successful implementation of the initial phase of this project is hereby enjoined.
