SECOND SERIES OF FOURTH LEVEL TRAINING  
FOR TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Coordinator, State Colleges  
and Universities  
Schools Superintendents

1. This Office has been informed that a number of public school teachers who missed the Fourth Level Training Institute, for justifiable reasons, as well as a number of private school teachers desire to avail themselves of the benefits of the aforementioned institute.
2. To enable such teachers to benefit from participation in this program, schools superintendents are hereby authorized to organize a second series of the Fourth Level Training Program to end at least two weeks before the administration of the First Professional Board Examination for Teachers on April 2, 1978.
3. Superintendents are instructed to find out how many teachers desire such training, determine an appropriate training center convenient to the larger number of participants, and draw up the schedule for the training. The program may be started during the December vacation to allow sufficient time for the completion of the subjects specified.
4. Attention is invited to the guidelines on the program content contained in Department Memorandum No. 115, s. 1977, entitled "Training Institutes for School Officials and Teachers."
5. It is desired that this Department Memorandum be immediately disseminated to school officials and teachers concerned.
