NATIONAL WORKSHOP-SEMINAR IN MUSIC EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities  
School Superintendents

1. A national workshop-seminar in Music Education for the elementary grades for the Curriculum Project Phase IV of the Philippine Society for Music Education, under the joint sponsorship of this organization and the Department of Education and Culture, will be held at the Cultural Center of the Philippines, Little Theatre, Manila, on January 28-29, 1978. The theme of the workshop-seminar is: Improving Music Teaching in the Elementary School Through Effective Music Learning Experiences and Instructional Materials.

2. The objectives of the workshop-seminar are as follows:

- a. To evaluate music learning experiences and instructional materials prepared for each grade in the elementary school level.
- b. To gain insight into various music strategies and to use those strategies effectively.

3. Each division may send the division music supervisor and not more than five elementary grades music teachers as participants to this workshop-seminar.

4. Private schools may also send their music coordinators and special music teachers to this seminar.

5. A workshop-seminar fee of P30 will be charged each participant to cover expenses for handouts and other music materials. Teachers involved in the preparation of working papers for the workshop will pay a fee of only P20 each.

6. ~~Travel expenses and other expenses incidental~~ to the attendance at this workshop may be charged against local funds subject to their availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Private schools participants may charge all their expenses against the school they are representing.

7. It is requested that all reservations be made not later than December 31, 1977. Applications may be sent to Prof. Crispina S. Garcia, Philippine Normal College or to Dean Corazon S. Neebe, Philippine Women's University-College of Music. Prepaid reservations are preferred.

8. Inclosed is a copy of the Program of Activities. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Department Memorandum is desired.
