SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON "GEARING THE TEACHING
OF SCIENCE TO FISHERY EDUCATION"

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Vocational School Principals/Administrators

1. A seminar-workshop on "Gearing the Teaching of Science to Fishery Education" will be conducted at the Apolinario R. Apacible School of Fisheries, Nasugbu, Batangas on February 6-10, 1978.
2. The following objectives are expected to be achieved in this five-day seminar-workshop:
 - a. To identify and discuss the appropriate areas in secondary science where fisheries can be properly interrelated.
 - b. To demonstrate the use of some equipment in learning concepts in fishery science.
 - c. To demonstrate proper handling, care and maintenance of fishery science equipment.
 - d. To prepare enrichment materials (modules for teaching science in fishery schools).
3. Attached is a daily schedule of activities (Inclosure No. 1).
4. Fishery schools and colleges listed in Inclosure No. 2 should send one teacher/instructor of science (chemistry or biology) and one teacher/instructor of fisheries preferably Fish Capture as participants from each region.
5. As a resource person, this training program shall utilize the services of the Japanese Science Educational Expert under the Colombo Plan-JICA Assistance Program who is based in the Apolinario R. Apacible School of Fisheries. Other resource persons are specialists in science education from the UPSSC and DSE.

6. Participants are allowed traveling expenses and per diems chargeable against local school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Expenses of resource persons/consultants shall be borne by their respective offices.

7. A registration fee of 750 will be collected from each participant to cover the cost of materials for handouts and chemicals to be used.

8. Dissemination of the contents of this Department Memorandum is desired.
