1. Conformably to Republic Act No. 4116, the opening date for school year 1978-1979 is June 13, 1978. Inclosed is the school calendar for 1978-1979.

2. The school year shall consist of not less than forty (40) weeks. The semestral term for collegiate courses shall consist of not less than eighteen (18) weeks with two (2) weeks of semestral vacation.

3. For school year 1978-1979, the following inclusive dates for the periods indicated shall be observed:

- a. The school year starts on June 13, 1978 and ends on March 30, 1979.
- b. Christmas vacation starts on December 17, and ends on December 30, 1978. Classes resume on January 2, 1979.
- c. The long vacation commences on April 1, 1979 and ends on June 9, 1979.
- d. Collegiate summer classes shall cover a six-week period from April 16 to May 26, 1979. Secondary summer classes shall cover a seven-week period from April 16, to June 2, 1979.

4. Within otherwise specified, the suspension of classes shall be implemented either and for other cause shall be governed by the provisions of Department Order No. 17, s. 1970.

5. To addition to legal holidays and special holidays authorized by Presidential Proclamation, the Secretary of Education and Culture may authorize the observance by public and private schools of other special holidays, subject to the issuance of memoranda by the respective regional offices concerned.

6. Any modification by schools, colleges, and universities, public or private, on the school calendar as herein prescribed shall have the prior approval of the Secretary of Education and Culture.
