**SEMINAR-WORK CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION
FOR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION, INC.**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges
and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Vocational Schools Superintendents/
Principals/Administrators

1. A three-day seminar-work conference of representatives of vocational schools and colleges will be conducted at the Negros Occidental College of Arts and Trades and the Bacolod City National Trade School, Bacolod City, on May 24-26, 1978, on the theme "Countryside Development Through Vocational Education."

2. The objectives of the seminar-work conference are as follows:

- a. To make a general assessment of vocational-technical education programs and the problems encountered in the effective implementation of such programs and to discuss alternative solutions thereto, and
- b. To formulate plans and evolve programs for the active participation and involvement of vocational-technical schools in the implementation of non-formal education programs of the Department of Education and Culture, as provided for in Presidential Decree No. 139.

3. The following personnel are expected to attend the seminar-work conference:

- a. One (1) administrator or head of the vocational school/college which has a local PAVE Chapter duly registered with the national PVE, or his duly authorized representative;

- b. The President of the local school/college PAVE Chapter, or his duly authorized representative who is an active PAVE member;
 - c. One ranking PAVE school chapter member and one PAVE member from the regional office;
 - d. Members of working committees assigned in the 19th Annual PAVE Convention; and
 - e. Thirteen (13) regional PAVS awardees for "Outstanding Vocational Teachers" who will be awarded during the convention.
4. In connection with the thirteen (13) regional PAVE awardees for "Outstanding Vocational Teachers", it is desired that regional committees be formed in each region to receive nominations from the schools and make the final selection of the awardee in their respective regions. The names of the regional awardees should reach the PAVE Office, c/o Bureau of Secondary Education, Manila not later than March 30, 1978.
5. Attendance of delegates to this seminar-work conference shall be considered official. Expenses incurred by the delegates and a registration fee of ₱250 per participant shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. It is requested that this Department Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible.
