NATIONAL SEMINAR ON THE ROLE OF FILIPINO IN COLLEGE

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents of State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. To provide a developmental program toward the effective implementation of bilingual education in the tertiary level as provided for in Department Orders Nos. 25 and 50, series 1974 and 1975, respectively, two national seminars on the teaching of Filipino in college courses and its use as a medium of instruction in the field of social sciences will be held under the joint sponsorship of the Bureau of Higher Education, the Institute of National Language and the Pambansang Samahang Linggwistikang Pilipino, Inc. The seminar for Luzon will be held at the U.S.F. College of Education auditorium in Manila on March 3-4, 1978 and the one for Visayas and Mindanao will be held in Cebu City at the St. Theresa's College auditorium on March 10-11, 1978.

2. The theme of the seminars is: The Role of Filipino in Tertiary Education. The objectives are as follows:

- a. To assess the present status of the teaching and use of Filipino as medium of instruction in college;
- b. To orient the participants on the actual teaching and use of Filipino as medium of instruction in the various college courses; and
- c. To consider effective measures on how to enhance the teaching and use of Filipino as medium of instruction in the tertiary level.

3. The participants of the seminar shall be the following:

- a. Chiefs of Higher Education Division;
- b. Regional Supervisors in-charge of the implementation of bilingual education;
- c. Department Heads of Social Sciences in institutions of higher learning;
- d. Department heads or instructors of Filipino in institutions of higher learning.

Each institution of higher learning should send two or more representatives. The names and designations of the participants should be furnished the Bureau of Higher Education as soon as possible.

4. Attendance will be on official time. A registration fee of P60 will be charged to cover expenses for handouts and snacks. Transportation, travel allowances, per diems and other incidental expenses including the registration fee of the participants from private institutions will be borne by their respective institutions, while those of participants from government agencies will be charged against local funds subject to existing auditing rules and regulations.

5. Inclosed is the tentative program of activities for the seminar.
