ENROLLMENT IN MIDWIFERY SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. In view of the change of the midwifery curriculum from an eighteen (18) month or a three (3) semester course to a two (2) year or four (4) semester course and the increased number of graduate midwives the number of admission periods to the course is hereby revised.
2. All schools offering the midwifery curriculum are hereby instructed to limit their enrollment period to only once a year, i.e. at the beginning of the school year, effective the school year 1978-1979. This strategy will also allow the faculty of midwifery schools to follow regular semester's work.
3. Immediate dissemination and implementation of this Department Memorandum is desired.
