SUMMER IN-SERVICE TRAINING FOR TEACHERS AND
INSTRUCTORS OF FISHERIES (PHASE II)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The Summer In-Service Training for Teachers and Instructors of Fisheries (Phase II) will be conducted during the next three summer terms in cooperation with the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources, Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources.

2. This program is a continuation of the successive summer institutes in fisheries which were held at Marikina, Metro Manila from 1975 to 1977.

3. The Mindanao Regional School of Fisheries, Zamboanga City, has been selected as venue for the first summer program (Phase II) scheduled on April 11 - May 9, 1978. Training sites for succeeding programs will be announced in due time.

4. The participants for Phase II summer programs shall be limited only to those teachers and instructors of Fisheries who started attending this special program at the Marikina School of Arts and Trades. The schedule of attendance shall be distributed as follows:

5. After summer 1976 this crash program shall be phased out. Those who desire to continue with their undergraduate degree in Fisheries may enrol in the regular degree program of the schools.

6. The scheme of accreditation provided for the 1st phase of the training in Department Memorandum No. 235, s. 197 shall likewise be applied to participants of the second phase who complete the three summer trainings. They shall be deemed as having completed all the requirements for the degree of Bachelor of Science in Fishery by fishery schools authorized to grant such accreditation.

7. Participants are allowed travelling expenses and per diems chargeable against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

8. The honorarium of the professorial staff which will be composed of specialists in fisheries from SEAFDEC, BFAR and DCC, and expenses for supplies, materials and field trips to be incurred during this summer program shall be borne by the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources.

9. The names of the participants from each region shall be sent to reach this Office, addressed to: Staff Development Division, Bureau of Secondary Education, Arroceros, Manila, not later than March 15, 1978.

10. It is desired that the contents of this Department Memorandum be disseminated immediately to all concerned.
