71ST ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE

1. The Philippine Medical Association will hold its 71st Annual Convention on April 16-22, 1978 at the Philippine International Convention Center, Manila, under the auspices of the Quezon City Medical Society, Inc.
2. The convention will focus on how practising physicians may be able to face the current challenges in the field of medicine. Distinguished speakers and authorities in their own fields have been invited to participate in the various scientific sessions and activities scheduled during the affair.
