CITIZEN ARMY TRAINING INSTRUCTORS COURSE (CATIC)  
FOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities  
Schools Superintendents  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Administrators/Principals of Secondary Schools

1. The Department of National Defense/Armed Forces of the Philippines and the Department of Education and Culture will jointly conduct the Citizen Army Training Instructor course (CATIC) for high school teachers at the University of the Philippines, Department of Citizen Military Training, Diliman, Quezon City, during the period 1-30 April 1978. This will be a non-live-in training. Teacher-trainees will report from 8:00 A.M. and will be dismissed at 5:00 P.M. for each scheduled training day.
2. The objective of the course is to qualify high school teachers to be commandants and instructors for Citizen Army Training (CAT).
3. Training support will be provided by the DND/AFP while transportation and maintenance of trainees will be charged against available local funds.
4. Each region may send to this training forty (40) participants.
5. For the purpose of coordinative planning as requested by DND/AFP, the list of participants from each region should be sent to reach this Office, Attention: Staff Development Division, Bureau of Secondary Education, not later than March 25, 1978, following the attached form.

6. It is requested that this Department Memorandum be given immediate wide publicity.
