SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON SHARING IDEAS ON FOOD RESOURCES

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors

1. In connection with its 19th Annual National Convention, the Biology Teachers Association of the Philippines (BIOTA), jointly with the Department of Education and Culture, will hold a seminar-workshop on "Sharing Ideas on Food Resources" at the Mariano Marcos Memorial College of Science and Technology, Batang, Ilocos Norte from April 11 to 13, 1978.
2. The objectives of this program are as follows:
  - a. To develop awareness among high school teachers and instructors of biology of the value of indigenous food resources available in different regions of the country; and
  - b. To improve teacher capability in conducting laboratory, marine and nature studies.
3. To achieve the above objectives, discussions and workshops on wild root crops, soft-shelled univalves and other aquatic animals which may be utilized for food shall highlight the program. Preparation of fresh mounts and biological techniques on nature and marine studies will also be demonstrated.
4. Biology teachers and instructors as well as science supervisors whose major field of specialization is biological science may attend the seminar-workshop.
5. A registration fee of 755 will be charged each participant to cover the cost of materials for handouts, field trips and other laboratory expenses. All expenses including this fee shall be chargeable against available local funds subject to auditing rules and regulations.
