CADET/CADETTE OFFICERS LEADERSHIP TRAINING (COLT)  
FOR VOLUNTEER CAT I

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Department of National Defense/Armed Forces of the Philippines and the Department of Education and Culture will jointly conduct the Cadet/Cadette Officers Leadership Training (COLT) for Volunteer CAT I at the University of the Philippines, Department of Citizen Military Training, Diliman, Quezon City, during the period 1-30, April, 1978.
2. The objective of the course is to develop a highly motivated and efficient corps of officers for CAT I Units and is intended for cadet/cadette officers of Metro Manila. However, students in the provinces who are recommended by their school heads to attend this training program will be accepted provided the allocation of 4,000 trainees will not be exceeded.
3. As this will be a non-live-in training, trainees will report from 8:00 A.M. and will be dismissed at 5:00 P.M. for each scheduled training day.
4. Training facilities will be provided by the DND/AFP while each trainee will shoulder his/her own expense during the training period.
5. For the purpose of coordinative planning as requested by DND/AFP, the list of participants from each school should reach this Office, Attention: Staff Development Division, Bureau of Secondary Education, not later than March 25, 1978.

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be given immediate wide publicity for the information of all concerned.
