NATIONAL TRAINING IN ARNIS FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION
TEACHERS IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Conformably with the provisions of Department Order No. 32, s. 1975 regarding the popularization of arnis in all schools, a national training in arnis for physical education teachers in secondary schools will be conducted at the Philippine Normal College Health Education Center, Ayala Boulevard, Manila, on May 29-June 2, 1978 under the joint sponsorship of the Department of Education and Culture and the National Arnis Association of the Philippines (NARAPHIL).

2. The main purpose of this training program is to equip physical education teachers with the basic skills in arnis through participation in different exercises of the sport. After their basic arnis training, the teachers are expected to promote arnis in their respective schools and thereby contribute to the preservation of this traditional martial art.

3. Each region may send to the training ten (10) secondary school physical education teachers (male or female), and the DDC, Manila, twenty (20) participants with specialization in physical education.

4. Participants should register at the PNC Health Education Center on May 29, 1978 from 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 A.M. Each participant shall pay a registration fee of ₱100 to cover the cost of rattan sticks, handouts and other expenses incident to the training.

5. Traveling expenses, per diem and registration fees of participants from the regions shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. The registration fee of DDC participants, who will be on official time only during their attendance in this training, shall be charged against the funds of their respective offices.

6. The list of participants from each reader should be forwarded to this Office, Attention: Staff Development Division, Bureau of Secondary Education, not later than April 15, 1976, in the attached form.

7. It is requested that this Memorandum be given immediate publicity for the information and guidance of all concerned.
