A. DEC. OFFICIALS TO AVOID ATTENDING FUNCTIONS OF SOCIAL AFFAIRS
SPONSORED BY THE CHINESE ORGANIZATIONS IN THE PHILIPPINES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chief of Services and Heads of Units
Coordinators, State Colleges and Universities
School Superintendents

1. It has been observed that some national officials attend functions of social affairs sponsored by Chinese organizations in the Philippines, during which the flag of Taiwan is displayed and, sometimes, even the Taiwanese National Anthem, is played.

2. To avoid giving the impression that the officials of the government of the Philippines accept the idea that there are two Chinas, all School Officials are enjoined to avoid attending functions or social affairs sponsored by Chinese organizations of the Philippines.

3. Should an official find himself at such functions/social affairs, he should refrain from showing any indication that he is in sympathy with Taiwan.

4. Strict compliance with this Department Memorandum is desired.
