FIRST SCHOOL EXECUTIVE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
FOR ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The First School Executive Development Program (SEDP) for assistant superintendents will be conducted from May 3 to June 13 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
2. The SEDP, the first program under the aegis of the Civil Service Academy established by P.D. No. 1218, will be conducted jointly by the Department of Education and Culture and the Civil Service Commission.
3. Inclosed is a list of participants to this (first training program. The program is live-in. Board and lodging expenses for the duration of the program will be paid by the DEC. Participants will pay only their transportation expenses to and from their station, and a training fee of 7300 chargeable against local funds.
4. It is suggested that participants come to the program with necessary information on their division projects and programs and educational statistics which may be needed in certain exercises.
5. Participants are requested to submit a health certificate duly signed by a government physician, attesting to their physical fitness to undertake a training program in Baguio City.
