ANNOUNCING THE 1978-1979 YCAP CALENDAR

<u>DATE</u>	<u>ACTIVITIES</u>
June 6-10, 1978	<u>Echo Seminar on the 1978-1979 Seven (7) YCAP Program Thrusts</u>  Delegates to the summer institute for YCAP coordinators (Phase I and Phase II) are expected to map out plans and conduct echo-seminars for all division/district/school coordinators.
July 2, 1978	<u>Launching of YCAP Projects</u>  Different regions/divisions/districts/schools shall draw up plans for the formal launching of the seven (7) YCAP program thrusts.
July 10-14, 1978 November, 1978 (Semestral)	<u>Orientation on YCAP for Students in all Schools</u>  School YCAP coordinators shall orient YCAP enrollees on the national development goals and the seven (7) YCAP program thrusts.
July 31, 1978 March, 1979	<u>Follow-up of Projects</u>  The National YCAP Coordinating Center, Science Foundation of the Philippines, and the Dangerous Drugs Board personnel shall observe on-going YCAP projects on the regional/division/district/school levels.
September, 1978	<u>Science Consciousness Week (PUSIE-YCAP)</u>  Science quizzes, science fairs, etc.
October 16-21, 1978 April 2-29, 1979	<u>Regional YCAP Social Laboratory</u>  This will be on a multi-agency approach. Each region shall identify a

depressed area where YCAP coordinators will map out plans for socio-economic improvement and where YCAP students shall serve as the manpower resource.

Regional Consultative Conference on the Implementation of YCAP Action Plan

March 5-9, 1978

YCAP Recognition Week

Identification and selection of the most outstanding YCAP projects/students/coordinators at the school/district/division/regional levels shall be conducted in preparations for the National YCAP Awards Day. Graduation ceremonies shall be held in each school for all YCAP participants for the year.

April 9-13, 1979

Summer Sail-on Institute for YCAP Youth Leaders

At least one (1) male and one (1) female outstanding YCAP youth leaders in each school/division and in colleges/universities throughout the country are enjoined to participate in the summer sail-on institute which shall be conducted inter-country. This activity envisions the creation of a Youth Speakers Bureau on the national development goals and the seven (7) YCAP program thrusts. Participation of Asian youths will be encouraged.

May 1, 1979

National YMAP Awards Day

Awarding ceremonies for outstanding national YMAP projects/coordinators/students and participating agencies.

May 7-27, 1979

Summer Leadership Institute for YMAP  
Coordinators on Youth Volunteer  
Management

1. Participants who attended the first phase institute are expected to complete the final phase of the program.
2. Outstanding YMAP District/Division/regional coordinators shall be selected to attend the second set of the institute who shall compose the phase I.
