1978 MID-YEAR SEMINAR ON RIZAL

1. The Office of the Rights of Rizal, in cooperation with the Department of Education and Culture, will conduct its 1978 Mid-Year Seminar on Rizal on June 13-14, 1978, at the National Library Auditorium, T.M. Yalaw, Ermita, Manila, in commemoration of the 117th birth anniversary of Dr. Jose Rizal. The theme will be "Rizal's Relevance in Countryside Development." This activity is in line with the Government's program of involving the people in the task of nation building. More particularly, it will stress the involvement of teachers and educators in moulding the moral character of the youth for better and constructive citizenship as well as enlightened nationalism.

2. Four (4) sub-topics will be discussed, namely: (a) Industry and Countryside Development; (b) Tourism and Countryside Development; (c) Military Service and Countryside Development; and (d) Education and Countryside Development.

3. Distinguished persons or officials scheduled to speak in the seminar will include the following:
